

Position Title: Project Development Manager

Reports to: CEO of TSFE Infrastructure & Utilities Subfund

Purpose

The primary role of the individual holding this position is to manage the development of the projects in which TSFE's Infrastructure & Utilities Subfund co- invests in. The person in this role is responsible for monitoring and tracking the contractually designated project schedule and deliverables, ensuring adherence to contract requirements and timely execution. Works with internal & external stakeholders to insure the timely execution of the projects. Ideally this person would have managed the process of closing large infrastructure project. The candidate's ideal background would be infrastructure/energy teams within DFIs and/or infrastructure developers/funds.

Essential Functions

- Serve as a Project development Manager—including responsibilities to co-develop infrastructure projects, coordinate with investment team within TSFE an external counter parties, serve as a focal point for project development review & verify technical assumptions related to projects in dealing with legal, technical & financial advisors.
- Perform various business-related duties supporting the development, analysis, and technical aspects of infrastructure and utilities projects.
- Coordinate and follow up with different teams across the organization to complete projects on time and on budget.
- Comfortable with project documents agreements & structure.
- Set and continually manage project and program expectations while delegating and managing deliverables with team members and stakeholders.
- Ensures the timely execution of projects with a focus on quality deliverables. Facilitates hand-off meetings and kick-off meetings to identify potential risks and work with the project team to develop and communicate contingency plans.

Education And Experience

- Previous experience that provides the knowledge, skills, and abilities to perform the job (comparable to 10+ years) or equivalent and relevant combination of education, training, & experience.
- 5 years in project development.
- Years of experience refers to typical years of related experience needed to gain the required knowledge, skills, and abilities necessary to perform the essential functions of the job. Years of experience are not to be used as the only determining factor in establishing the job class or making employment selection decisions.
